



ARRIVING & EXITING THE ARENA January 2021

BEFORE LEAVING HOME

- Complete online Health Screening Questionnaire no more than one hour prior to arrival each night – **BOTH** skaters and parent/guardian entering the arena must complete the screening – verbal screening will be conducted upon arrival if online screening is not submitted
- Dress ready to go on the ice – there will be no access to dressing rooms at this time. Please use a small bag to carry skates. Space is limited - **PLEASE** do not bring hockey bags, large skate bags, backpacks, etc. into the arena
- DO NOT leave home if you are feeling unwell or showing signs of Covid-19 or if you answered yes to any of the questions on the Health Screening Questionnaire

ARRIVAL AT THE ARENA

- **One parent/guardian per family** permitted into the arena – for Parent & Tot program this will be the parent/guardian on the ice - no siblings or other family members will be granted access at this time per *Town of Orangeville Facility protocol* - the number of people in the facility must stay under the allowable limit during each program as well as during crossovers between programs
- Arrive no more than **15** minutes before your scheduled ice time. Proceed to **TONY ROSE** lobby entrance. Skaters and parents/guardians wait outside the lobby doors (mask on and distanced) until a coach, board member or volunteer lets you into the arena
- All skaters and parents/guardians **MUST** wear a face mask when entering the arena and please sanitize hands at the sanitizing station provided
- Proceed to check-in and screening table inside the front entrance – the volunteer will either confirm your health screening has been completed on-line or will conduct the screening – this screening point will close once skaters take to the ice – entry into the building will not be permitted 10 minutes after program start time per *Town of Orangeville Facility protocol*
- Skaters in the Canskate and Parent & Tot programs will be provided with name tag at the first class that will be taken home and must be worn each class for attendance and assessment purposes
- After screening, enter through the **A Rink entrance** and proceed to designated change area as directed – put skates on – remove mask and put helmet on – wait until instructed to enter ice
- Skaters enter ice as directed by coach – skaters must maintain distance from coaches and other participants at all times
- Parents/guardians may spectate from their designated chair/seat in change area only – masks on and distanced at all times – walking around the rink is not permitted – there will be no further access into the building if you choose to leave

END OF CLASS

- skaters exit ice as directed by coach and meet parent/guardian
- remove helmet and put mask on – remove skates
- exit as directed within 10 MINUTES of leaving the ice to facilitate the arrival of the next group
